Dear Parents and Carers,

Covid Self-Isolation

I am sure you are now aware that the period of self-isolation has now reduced. If your child has tested positive for Covid 19, you should re-test them on the morning of day 5 and if it is negative, you should retest again on the morning of day 6. If this is also negative, they can return to school on day 6. If positive, continue retesting until 2 negative test 24 hours apart or the 10 day isolation period has ended. Please send a screen shot of the texts you receive when you register the negative tests, to the Academy Office or to your child's class teacher, via dojo. If your child has not had 2 negative tests before the 10 day isolation, then they cannot return to school until the end of the isolation period. If you are unsure, please call the Academy office for further advice.
